OVERALL ASSESSMENT AND COMMENTS

The Audit team visited and verified the works done by the faculty. The Audit team interacted with the faculty and students. The academic and Administrative Audit report demonstrates the performance of the institution.

Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Teacher Education is an institution under Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan, the Kerala Chapter of the NGO Vidya Bharathi. The college is affiliated to University of Calicut started functioning in 20009 with an intake of 100 students for B Ed program in six optional subjects. In 2005 Two-year B Ed Program introduced and we have an intake of 100 students for the same in seven optional subjects-English, Sanskrit, Commerce, Mathematics, Natural Science, Physical Science and Social Science. The college was accredited by NAAC with B grade, CGPA 2.01 in 2022. The first AQAR for the academic year 2022-2023 was submitted in December 2023. The college is following the curriculum prescribed for B Ed course by the University of Calicut. According to the academic calendar provided by the university, the academic council prepares the college academic calendar in a flexible mode to smoothen the implementation. The institution facilitates student centric learning with initiatives such as ASAP and value-added courses. Remedial coaching is given to weaker students. Feedback on curriculum is taken from students, alumni, faculty and employers and actions are taken as per the analysis reports.

Faculty evaluation is done by the students. Performance of faculty is assessed by Principal and Manager through the evaluation by students and self-appraisal. Among the faculty two are doing regular Ph D and four are doing part time PhD.

The Teaching learning process involves lectures, demonstrations, assignments, group discussions, seminars, workshops and expert talks. ICT enabled teaching is followed.

Students are continuously assessed through unit tests and model examinations. Peer teaching, supervised study, Mentor-mentee system and remedial coaching are carried out for improving the academic standards.

Seminars, workshops and Add on courses were conducted for the promotion of knowledge. The college has a Research Journal publication in March 2024. The institution has signed MoUs with various institutions of academic excellence.

Library is automated with Integrated Library Management System KOHA. all the books are barcoded. The Library has the following resources.
