

 - III. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.



WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Education, Kallekkad Post, Pallakkad District – 678015, Kerala has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed., which require additional facilities.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- (i) The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.
- (ii) The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- (iii) The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate(EC), Land Use Certificate(LUC) and the Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- (iv) The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Education, Kallekkad Post, Pallakkad District – 678015, Kerala for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session 2015-16 subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely, **Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Teacher Education, Kallekkad (Post), Palakkad (District) – 678015, Kerala** vide SRC (NCTE) order No. F.KL/SRO/NCTE/2008-09/4193 dated 26.08.2008 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic session 2008-2009.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution by consented to come under new Regulations vide a notarized affidavit dated 19.01.2015.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a Revised Provisional Recognition Order (RPRO) was issued to the institution on 13.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter regarding compliance by the institutions of the conditions of the revised recognition order, was placed before the SRC in its 369th meeting held on 28.01.2019 and the committee decided that Show Cause Notice be issued to all such institutions which have not submitted compliance.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, Show Cause Notice issued on 04.10.2019. The institution vide letter dated 22.10.2019 submitted reply to Show Cause Notice.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, The matter was further considered by the SRC in its 386th meeting held on 23rd & 24th July, 2020 and the Committee decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice.

7. **AND WHEREAS**, Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 05.08.2020 to reply within 21 days. The institution submitted its reply on 25.09.2020 & 09.12.2020, 14.12.2020.

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was further considered by the SRC in its 392th meeting held on 15th – 16th December, 2020 and the Committee decided as follows:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

On the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, the Committee decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Teacher Education, Kallekkad (Post), Palakkad (District)- 678015, Kerala for B.Ed programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each unit."

9. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution **Bharatheeya Vidya Nikethan College of Teacher Education, 89A1,A2,88/1D, Kallekkad (Post), Palakkad (District)- 678015, Kerala** for B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units) subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
 - II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
 - IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.




